Finance

Indonesian banks provide ATMs in most parts of the country. They accept major credit cards such as Visa, Master Cards, Citi Bank, JCB, American Diners, Union Pay, Maestro. You can use your local cards in ATMs with Visa, Master Card, Cirrus, JCB, Union Pay access. Money Changers can be found at the airport and local licensed money changers in major cities including Semarang. For participants from countries, which do not have access to those financial services, please arrange accordingly for your own convenience. Major currencies are accepted in money changers and banks.

Communication

Complimentary Wi-fi are available at Indonesian airports, Grand Candi Hotel and Universitas Diponegoro. In most cafe, restaurants and other public areas Wi-fi are free. Although Wi-fi is free, log-in is still needed. As for telephone, international connections are available. Please check your service provider prior to your departure.

Transportation

Complimentary pick-up service from Ahmad Yani International Airport (SRG) to Grand Candi Hotel and vice versa has been arranged for all participants and speakers as well as from/to Hotel to/from Universitas Diponegoro. Please send Ms. Sabrina your flight details for pick-up schedule prior to your departure. In case, you need public transportation, you can take taxi at the airport terminal, or you can order private car by application (Uber, Go-Jek or Grab).

We would like to suggest your careful planning on your flight as local flights from/to Semarang are not frequent.

Dress Code

We encourage visitors to dress decently when visiting Semarang and other public areas. In the workshop the dresscode is smart/formal. For the Borobudur trip, we recommend

casual clothes and comfortable shoes. A hat/cap would be useful as it can be hot during the day.






